<b>Weekday</b>	Monday to Friday 6am-8pm
<b>Weekday Evening</b>	Monday to Friday 8pm to midnight (Weekday shifts that end after 8pm will be charged at the evening rate for the whole of the shift)
<b>Weekday Night</b>	Monday to Friday midnight to 6am and any hours associated with a sleepover (including active overnight hours during a sleepover and any shift immediately before or after a sleepover).
<b>Saturday</b>	From midnight Friday to midnight Saturday
<b>Sunday</b>	From midnight Saturday to midnight Sunday
<b>Public Holiday</b>	From midnight the night before to midnight of the Public Holiday
<b>Sleepover</b>	This is a flat rate for the 8 hours where there is no expectation of being woken, and the support worker is provided with a separate room with a bed. It does include up to 2 hours of assistance where required. Any hours over 2 hours will be charged at active night rates as well as the sleepover, up to four hours and then the whole shift will be at active rates. A minimum four-hour shift either before or after the sleepover is required to be booked with the sleepover.
<b>Minimum Shift</b>	2 hours is the minimum shift time. Shifts will be charged and paid in 15 min increments thereafter.
<b>Transport Kilometres</b>	The participant/participant's family is responsible for costs kilometres not included in your plan or are not plan managed as part of excursion costs
<b>Non-Face-To-Face</b>	Additional activities outside of normal service provision (e.g., report writing, funding escalations, attending external meetings)
<b>Excursion costs</b>	The participant/participant's family is responsible for costs relating to excursions (e.g. swimming pool entrance) for the support worker/participant
<b>GST</b>	Does not apply to government subsidised care, however there are exceptions
<b>Note</b>	Fees are subject to review in line with NDIS price reviews
